## WATER WELL AND SOIL TESTING

- Well Water: \$15/sample. Collect in a new water bottle, 12-20oz, directly from spigot, within 24 hours
  - Sample drop-off 8:30—10:30 a.m. **Aug. 11** at Karnes or Wilson AgriLife Extension office.
- Soil: FREE testing. Follow submittal procedure at [soiltesting.tamu.edu](http://soiltesting.tamu.edu), pg. 2 Bring sample Aug. 12<sup>th</sup>
