

**Evergreen UWCD's Notice of Public Comment Period and Hearing  
on the Proposed Desired Future Conditions of the Aquifers by GMAs 13 and 15**

The Evergreen Underground Water Conservation District (EUWCD) is currently receiving public comments on proposed desired future conditions (DFCs) for the relevant aquifers in Atascosa, Frio, Karnes and Wilson counties through 2080 until August 31, 2026, pursuant to §36.108, Texas Water Code. The EUWCD will hold a public hearing on the proposed DFCs on June 26, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., at 110 Wyoming Blvd, Pleasanton, Texas 78064. Groundwater Management Area 13 (GMA 13) has proposed the following DFCs through 2080, expressed as average drawdown from 2017 conditions: Carrizo-Upper Wilcox: Atascosa 95 ft; Frio 153 ft; Karnes and Wilson 77 ft; Middle and Lower Wilcox: Atascosa, Frio, Wilson 113 ft; Queen City: Atascosa 54 ft; Frio 66 ft; Wilson 32 ft. The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) designated GMA 13 to include: EUWCD, Gonzales County Underground Water Conservation District (UWCD), Guadalupe County Groundwater Conservation District (GCD), McMullen GCD, Medina County GCD, Plum Creek Conservation District, Uvalde County UWCD, and Wintergarden GCD. Groundwater Management Area 15 (GMA 15) has proposed the following DFCs through 2080, expressed as average drawdown from 2000 conditions: Gulf Coast Aquifer System: Karnes 22 ft. The TWDB designated GMA 15 to include: EUWCD, Bee GCD, Calhoun County GCD, Coastal Bend GCD, Coastal Plains GCD, Colorado County GCD, Corpus Christi Aquifer Storage & Recovery CD, Fayette County GCD, Goliad County GCD, Pecan Valley GCD, Refugio GCD, Texana GCD, and Victoria County GCD.
